FCPS should monitor implementation of the new start times to determine if the intended outcomes are being achieved and for opportunities to improve them. There was a cost attached to changing start times during a period where FCPS is forecasting a significant budget deficit. I would like to see specific FCPS data rather than national reports that shows changing start times are worth the investment. This data can come through better test scores, reduction in absences or tardiness, and fewer disciplinary problems. I would also like to remedy the middle school start times soon. I have heard stories of students waiting at the bus stop in the dark at 6:30 by themselves. It's not safe for students to be walking and waiting at the bus stop by themselves at such an early time.
